EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

This form may be used to indicate interest of an organization or community in joining the Free Prior and Informed Consent (FPIC) Solutions Dialogue. Please review this document and send the completed, signed form to Taylor Kennedy at RESOLVE (tkennedy@resolve.ngo).

Process for Prospective Participants

The steps for organizations or communities interested in joining the FPIC Solutions Dialogue include the following:

1. Prospective Participants should send RESOLVE a completed, signed expression of interest, to be circulated to existing Dialogue members for review and approval.
2. RESOLVE will contact current members of the FPIC Solutions Dialogue to alert them of new prospective Participants and will share the signed expression of interest – with private contact details redacted, allowing a one-week window to share questions or concerns. Any questions or issues identified by current Participants will be raised for discussion with the relevant prospective Participant and with the FPIC Solutions Dialogue Steering Committee. The Steering Committee, a balanced committee composed of NGO, industry, and consultant representatives, will be responsible for a final decision on any issues that are flagged.
3. Concurrent to notification of all Dialogue Participants of the prospective Participant's interest, prospective Participants should also ensure they are aware of current FPIC Solutions Dialogue Participants and other prospective Participants, confirming mutual comfort of association.
4. At the end of the one week review period, prospective Participants who receive approval by existing members will be asked to re-affirm their interest and commitment.

Expectations of FPIC Solutions Dialogue Members

1. Demonstration of organizational commitment to the Dialogue through appointment of senior staff or member as primary or active participant.
2. Good faith effort to participate in one annual meeting and periodic (no more than quarterly) conference calls to conduct Dialogue business and review Dialogue products.
3. Commitment to working in a collaborative spirit with business, civil society, communities, and governments toward the development of practical guidance for all of these on the meaningful implementation of free, prior, and informed consent.
4. Willingness to share candid experience, lessons, and insights – and to treat in appropriate confidence information that is shared – toward the goal of broadening the collective knowledge base of the Dialogue.
5. Corporate participants are expected to provide an annual financial contribution to support the ongoing activities and costs of the Dialogue. For large-scale extractive companies and other private sector entities, the annual contribution is \$25,000; for small and medium extractive companies, it is \$10,000 annually.
